OPERATION ALAMO CRUCIFIX: A COUNTERTERRORISM CALL TO ARMS

Situation Report

The United States has been at war with radical Islam since 1979 when current Iranian President Mahmoud Ahmadinejad and hundreds of fellow student revolutionaries stormed its sovereign territory in Tehran and held the American embassy staff hostage for 444 days. Since that inauguration of terror, Islamic radicals have conducted the following atrocities against U.S. interests:

- Bombed the American Embassy in Beirut, Lebanon, April 18, 1983;
- Bombed the American Embassy Annex in Beirut, Lebanon, September 20, 1985;
- Bombed the Marine Headquarters, Beirut, Lebanon, October 23, 1983;
- Bombed the World Trade Center, New York City, New York, February 26, 1993;
- Bombed the Khobar Towers Complex, Dhahran, Saudi Arabia, June 25, 1996;
- Bombed the American Embassies in Nairobi, Kenya and Dar es Salaam, Tanzania, August 7, 1998;
- Bombed Pan American Airlines Flight 103 over Lockerbie, Scotland, December 21, 1988;
- Bombed the U.S.S. Cole, Aden Harbor, Yemen, October 12, 2000;
- Crashed American Airlines Flight 11 and United Airlines Flight 175 into the World Trade Center, New York City, American Airlines Flight 77 into the Pentagon, Washington D.C.; and lead to the crashing of United Airlines Flight 93 (destined for Washington, D.C.) in Pennsylvania on September 11, 2001;
- Planned or carried out numerous smaller acts of terrorism within the United States and throughout the world including four potential attacks uncovered this week ending September 27, 2001.

And that's just attacks against American interests. Islamic terrorists are operating throughout the Middle East, Northern and Eastern Africa, Europe, Latin America, East Asia, and Southeast Asia against Western communities and their allies. In fact, the only place where Islamic cells are not active at present is Antarctica. Give them time. Iraq and Afghanistan are merely square one and American freedom is the ultimate objective.

If the world did not take notice of the Islamists' intent to wage unconditional war upon the West – particularly the United States – by February 23, 1998, Usama bin Laden and Ayman al-Zawahiri removed all doubt when they released their written Fatwa to *“Kill the Americans and their allies – civilians and military”* which was to be *“an individual duty for every Muslim who can do it in any country in which it is possible to do it.”* This was before September 11, 2001 turned Islamic terrorism into a household word.

Sadly, however, after a bold strike against Taliban-led Afghanistan in 2001 and a subsequent invasion of Saddam Hussein's Iraq, Western resolve to destroy radical Islam is waning. At least from the Political and Public perspectives. U.S. military and federal forces are primed for the “long war” but a change in U.S. Administrations has seriously undermined America's ability to defend itself against this persistent evil. American politicians have decided that the appropriate function is to handcuff Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) operatives and empower the rights of Islamic terrorists rightfully serving time down at the military detention facility located at Guantanamo Bay, Cuba (GITMO).

Evil cannot be negotiated with, nor can rational minds prevail when irrational politicians seek to promote personal agendas at the expense of the security and defense of the United States of America and the inalienable rights of its citizenry. The current battle against Islamic fundamentalists arose when then President Jimmy Carter terminated 4,000 CIA officers the year before the takeover of the American Embassy in Tehran. Presently, the Obama Administration wants to investigate those charged with our defense for perceived crimes under the guise of national prestige. There are no rules when waging war except to win at all cost. To sacrifice our country to satisfy political courtesies will not make our nation any safer. Accordingly, those representing our interests in the nation's capital have failed to live up to our expectations and our respect for their efforts has been firmly extinguished.

Mission

American military and federal counterterrorism personnel need the public's assistance to carry on their fight against radical Islam. Their leaders, to whom they are bound to obey, have seriously undermined their capabilities, their funding, and their logistics. They are not in a position to corral these renegade politicians, but We the People are. Every leader in Washington, whether vetted by Congress or not, is servant to the American public and it is this citizenry that calls the shots – not the President, not the Congress, not even the Supreme Court. We are empowered by the United States Constitution to defend and to be defended. Anything less than this is pure treason. Since the federal government (excluding those on the frontlines against terrorism) has abdicated its role in protecting the population of the United States, then it falls upon the American citizen to ***“support and defend the Constitution of the United States against all enemies, foreign and domestic.”***

Execution and Concept of Operation

If the United States Government is incapable – or unwilling – to protect the public which it serves, then it is also quite unwilling to adequately prepare, train, and supply the citizens who are the very target of Islamic terrorism. Therefore, it becomes the right – and the “grave duty” – of the American public to defend itself at all costs; a duty that binds the individual to the Constitution, the Republic, and the defense of his or her fellow citizens.

Counterterrorist Code of Ethics

1. We respect the right of all peoples to embrace any organized religious practice of their choosing as long as it does not actively promote the destruction or subjugation of another culture;
2. We respect the right and legitimacy of indigenous peoples, their cultures, their national borders, their language, and their political affiliation so long as it does not promote the destruction or subjugation of another culture;

Counterterrorist Code of Ethics (Con't)

3. We hold that all humans were created equal in the eyes of God and therefore shall be respected as equals by all parties of this effort;
4. We shall defend innocent human lives to the best of our ability and, where appropriate, within the established laws of the indigenous legislative body;
5. We shall not interfere with or jeopardize any recognized law enforcement or military operation to the best of our ability. Where accepted, we shall actively assist such agencies to the best of our abilities;
6. We shall do all that we can to provide aid, comfort, and economic assistance to allied peoples regardless of their race, religion, social status, sex, or personal beliefs;
7. We shall never forget that our fundamental mission is to protect innocent human lives to the best of our ability.

This consideration has given rise to the development of the *Independent Counterterrorist* (ICT) Training Program, a private Internet-based effort to inspire the typical citizen into accepting some measure of responsibility for his or her own safety and survival. This program teaches the individual – regardless of whether they are a schoolteacher, truck driver, or bank teller – to condition their minds as if that of a “warrior” on the frontlines of battle. They are.

The Islamic terrorists who have targeted Americans – “civilians and military” – do not care about uniforms, military orders, or international conventions. They seek to destroy us in order to fulfill their perverted dreams of eternal paradise. As such, they cannot be defeated by wishful thinking or deferring our safety to the fine men and women actually taking up arms against these thugs. However, we – everyone of us – must take up our own arms, of a sort, to aid those under oath to protect us.

We can do so through the following:

1. Download and study the material presented within the ICT modules;
2. Never assume for a moment that we are safe from *any* harm;
3. Condition both our minds and our bodies to the peak of efficiency;
4. Understand that the radical Islamists desirous of our death are fanatically religious and are not afraid to die to achieve their goals;
5. Where permissible, obtain Concealed Carry Permits (CCW) and carry our firearm whenever we leave the house;
6. **Convince five of your closest friends and family to undertake these objectives.**
